# Campus Representative Program Description

## Overview

Welcome to the GSA Campus Representative Program. You are a vital part of a network of over 500 spokespersons for GSA on two- and four-year college and university campuses worldwide. You represent, in large part, the strength of the Society in future years.

GSA Campus Reps serve as ambassadors for GSA and its mission to their students and professional colleagues by disseminating information about the Society and encouraging their involvement.

## What to Expect

We will communicate with you primarily during the school year by email and via GSA's Connected Community. In addition, you will receive information regarding GSA opportunities, information about the annual and section meetings, and student and early career programs. We ask that you share these opportunities with your students and colleagues and encourage them to engage with the society.

We also hope that you will join us for the Campus Reps Appreciation Breakfast at the GSA Annual Meeting each year that you serve.

## Eligibility and Term of Service

As a GSA Campus Rep, you need only be a member of the Society in good standing, with a willingness to promote GSA membership and activities. You may serve as long as mutually agreeable to both you and GSA. You may terminate your service as a GSA Campus Rep at any time by notifying the program coordinator.
