## Statistics from recent years

~300-400 recipients annually

~50% success rate

Grant amounts range from \$400 to \$2,500 (excluding specialized grants)

Average grant amount is \$1,600–\$2,000, annually

## Division and Section Grants


Some GSA Divisions and GSA Sections offer additional grants outside of the main GSA Graduate Student Research Grant process.

- Provides partial support of master's and doctoral thesis research in the geosciences
- General grants are available, in addition to "specialized" grants for specific geographic areas and subject matter
- Research proposals are submitted online during December and January
- Applicants must be GSA student members
- Open to graduate students enrolled in universities in North and Central America
- Individuals may receive two graduate student research grants in their academic career
